

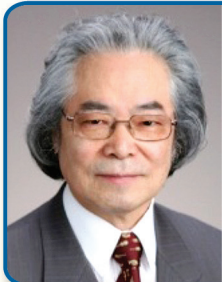

Keynote Speaker: Dr Hiroyuki Abe, President, International Society of Personalised Medicine, Founder and CEO of Hakushin Koseika Medical Foundation, Japan, runs the Abe Cancer Clinic in Tokyo, Japan, and has used fucoidan as a dietary supplement mainly with cancer patients for more than 20 years. Dr Abe is in his 70s and is a trained cardiothoracic surgeon. Dr Abe is the Supervising Editor for 'A Survey of Phytochemical Research' by Toyo Igakusha Co., Ltd, published in 2007. He is also working with advanced approaches to the treatment of cancer at his Tokyo clinic.

Mandarin Presenter: Dr Tan Yong Seng is a cardiothoracic surgeon in private practice. Previously he was the director of the Heart Lung Transplant Program at the National Heart Centre, Singapore (NHCS). Dr Tan is active in the medical and general communities and has published extensively in peer-reviewed local and international journals.
